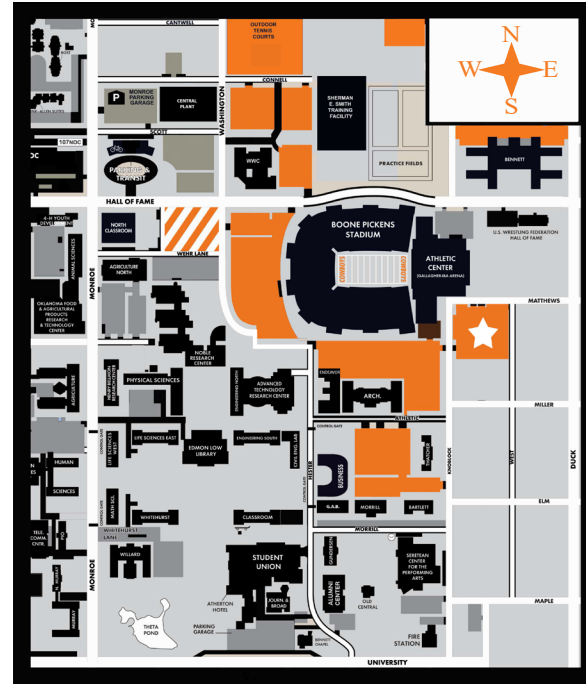

Bachelor's degree candidates who anticipate graduation in Spring or Summer 2019 are eligible to participate in their spring undergraduate commencement ceremony. ## CAPS, GOWNS, MEDALLIONS AND DIPLOMAS

Participants in all ceremonies must wear approved academic regalia, which is available through the University Store in the Student Union beginning March 13 (or online at [www.shopokstate.com](http://www.shopokstate.com)).

Doctoral regalia purchases can be made by special order year round. Orders for purchase must be received by 4 p.m. on Friday, March 8, or for rental beginning Monday, April 29, and must be returned by Wednesday, May 15.

Faculty who wish to rent a hood representing their alma mater must place their orders by Friday, March 29.

Medallions will be distributed to eligible candidates with their caps and gowns. Diplomas will be distributed by the Office of the Registrar to degree recipients approximately six to eight weeks following commencement.

## THE CEREMONY

The Oklahoma State University Pipes & Drums Band will lead the Saturday processions into Gallagher-Iba where candidates will be seated by college. Candidates will be announced individually, photographed and presented an OSU commencement print while crossing the stage. Graduates are expected to remain seated throughout the ceremony as a courtesy to their classmates. Individuals who participate in the commencement ceremony are expected to wear caps and gowns that are approved by the university. Appropriate attire is required. At the graduate ceremony, participants wear academic hoods appropriate to the advanced degree received.

## INFORMATION FOR YOUR GUESTS

OSU welcomes your family and friends to the commencement ceremonies. Ample seating is available in the upper levels of Gallagher-Iba. The diagram in this brochure guides guests to the seating closest to the college of their graduate. The Memorial Lobby at the south end of Gallagher-Iba will be closed prior to the ceremony so that staging for the processional can take place.

To ensure that all graduates are appropriately recognized, guests are asked to remain seated throughout the ceremony. A professional photographer will be on hand to take photographs as graduates cross the stage. A photo backdrop will be available on the north and south porticos outside of Gallagher-Iba Arena.

## PARKING AND ACCESSIBILITY

Parking is available on the northwest and south sides of the stadium. On Friday and Saturday, Lot 6B will be designated accessible parking and is on the south side of Gallagher-Iba Arena (see map on back panel). Accessible and wheelchair seating is available on the second level (concourse level) in the arena and is accessible by elevator. For questions regarding elevator access and seating locations, please see the security personnel at Gallagher-Iba.
